

Much has happened since the last album. After several performances on The Nashville Sessions' music, I found myself wanting to go back to my comfort zone of playing high octane guitar.

Interestingly, this album almost ended up becoming a double album - one disc for instrumentals, and one disc for songs. After much discussion and deliberation with my circle of peers though, I decided to keep it a single album.

The title "Time II Change" signifies many things for me. First off, changing from the straight ahead song-based music of The Nashville Sessions to much more progressive and instrumental-based music. Second, the fact that it's my second official album release. Third, the change that occurred by getting off the road with America - probably one of the biggest changes, as I have in form or another been with them since I graduated college. Lastly, and most fun, the fact that there's several odd time signatures floating around the song and the album. The second disc that got cut from this album has a lot of this too, and I eagerly look forward to releasing that soon!

I was lucky enough to have some great players on this music: Lester Estelle of Kelly Clarkson's band, Billy Nobel of Tim McGraw's band, Jayme Lewis of Jayme Lewis and my go-to player for all things bass, and I even had a guest drummer, my good friend Voyce McGinley of Kintaro!

I took on the monumental task of engineering, mixing, and producing this myself, although each of the players recorded their respective parts out of their own studios. The tones and parts they sent me were so good, I feel like I've cheated in some way. I'm very pleased with the results and I truly hope you are too.
